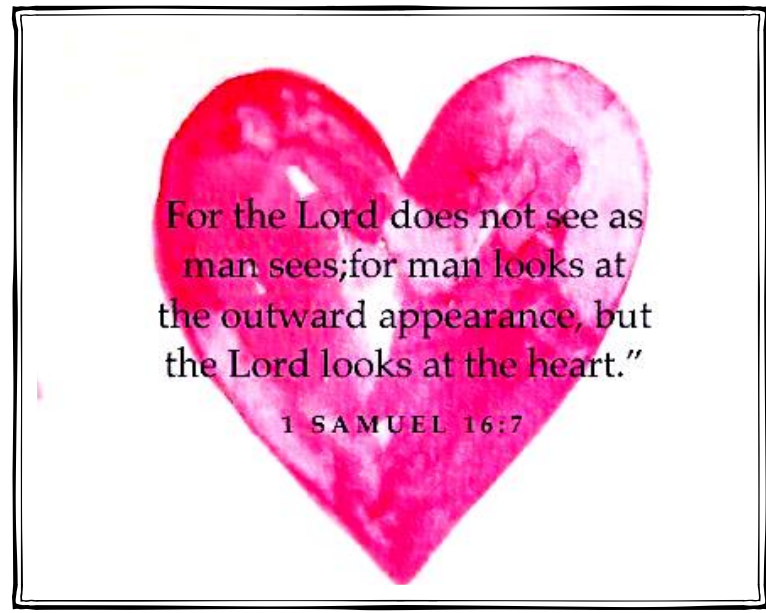

Not All Israel is Israel

This past weekend you probably saw some of the terrible things happening in the nation of Israel. Hundreds of people died, and thousands were injured as the terrorist group Hamas launched rockets, raped and abducted women and children, and many other terrors. There is no doubt that these things are evil and should be stopped. As people have spoken about Israel, there has been a lot of talk showing a basic misunderstanding about this nation in the Middle East which was formed after the completion of WW2. Israel, as we know it today, is not God's chosen people. It is only a physical nation like the USA, Mexico, India, etc.

In Genesis 12 God made a covenant with Abraham that his descendants would be made into a great nation. This same covenant was passed down to his sons, Isaac and Jacob. Jacob's name was changed to Israel in Genesis 32. His descendants became known as Israelites as we see them put into Egyptian captivity and led out through the Exodus. These descendants received a Law and sacrificial system at Mt. Sinai which was specifically for them. They eventually occupied the land of Canaan and became the great nation of Israel with kings like Saul, David, and Solomon. These were God's chosen covenant people and the name of "Israel" became synonymous with "God's Chosen People." Unfortunately, they did not keep the covenant they had agreed to with God and were carried away into captivity by the Assyrians and Babylonians. This is exactly what God told them would happen if they were not faithful.

When Jesus came, He established a New Covenant that was not only for the descendants of Abraham but for all men and women. (Gal. 3:28) Today, God's chosen people are those who have accepted and been washed in Jesus' blood...the Church that belongs to Jesus. We call these people Christians. (Acts 11:26) It is this reality Paul was referring to when he said in Romans 9:6, "For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel." God's Chosen is the Church of Christ based on His sacrifice for all men and not simply based on a physical relationship to Abraham.
