








Convicted

Conviction is a strong belief in something that is certain. The Bible is full of stories of people being convicted. Let's start with Abraham. In Genesis 22:9-11, God told Abraham to sacrifice Issac. Because of Abraham's strong belief in something certain, he was convicted to do what God told him to do. Trusting in God, he bound Issac and prepared him for sacrifice.

In Daniel, Chapter 6, a decree was declared requiring all bow down to King Nebuchadnezzar only, no other gods or human beings. Daniel, because of his strong belief in something that is certain, refused to bow to King Nebuchadnezzar. Instead, he continued to kneel and pray to his God three times a day.

Next, let's look at Joseph. In Genesis 39:7, Potiphar's wife said to Joseph "lie with me." Because of Joseph's strong belief in something that was certain, in Genesis 39:9, Joseph says "how can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?"

In Daniel 3, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, because of their strong belief in something that is certain, were put into a furnace that was ordered by King Nebuchadnezzar to be heated seven times more than normal.

These are four of the many stories in the Bible of fearless individuals that were willing to sacrifice everything because they had a strong belief in something that is certain which is our Lord and Savior!

So, in our lives today, where are we when it comes to our strong belief in something certain? Are we willing to sacrifice whatever we need to in order to give us the peace of knowing we will be in Heaven with our Lord and Savior no matter how painful it may be on this earth?

Are we CONVICTED to the Lord?
