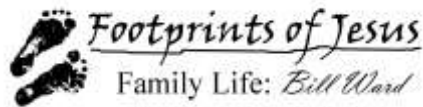

Tribute to Margaret Garner Tankersley

Sister Tankersley passed through the vale early February 17th at her home surrounded by loving family members. Her family had spent the nights with her at her house for some 2 ½ years and had done everything possible to meet her needs and make her comfortable during the final weeks of her life.

I enjoyed visiting with Sister Tankersley. She told many good stories and some sad. She attended the first Keeble tent meeting in Valdosta in 1930 when she was nearly 10 years old.

She was baptized when she was 12 years old and had remained a faithful member of the church for over 77 years.

She was tragically widowed when she was 30 with four young children; including 5 month old twins. She never showed any bitterness when talking of these very sad events and times. She loved her family and worked alone to raise them in the 1950s. Her house was filled with several generations of pictures. She was given to generous hospitality both to her family and to members of the church.

She remarried a preacher, Dodie Tankersley about 1967 and was a wonderful preacher's wife out at Redland for the next 11 ½ years. She did mission work door-knocking and conducting Bible studies in 1987 when the church started in Lakeland. After we moved to Lakeland in 1988, she, along with Ettie McWhorter and Van Thompson, would attend Sunday night services once a month. This was a very big encouragement to our family and the small church at Lakeland. This they did for about eighteen months.

She loved the church and taught Bible classes for over 40 years. After retiring in 1982, she soon began teaching the Tuesday Ladies class at Forrest Park as long as her memory and health allowed.

It bothered her greatly not to be able to assemble but she still made sure that her contribution was sent to the services regularly.

She faced her final illness without any bitterness and scarcely any word of complaint. She was always a delight to visit. I will miss her so very much. We loved her. God bless her family!
