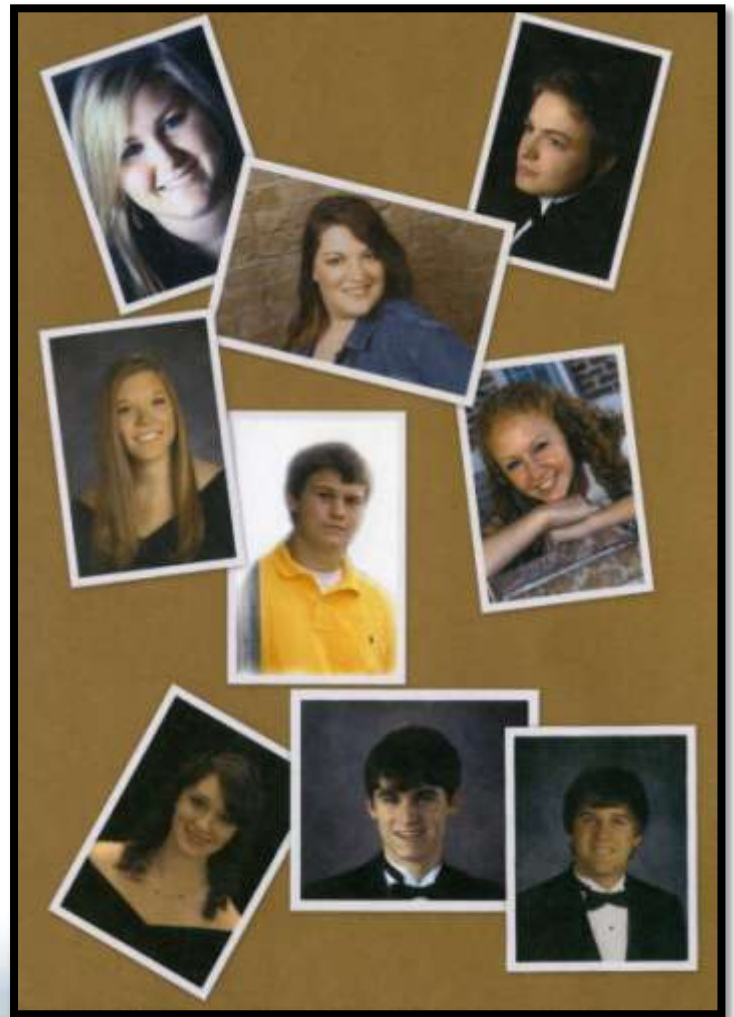

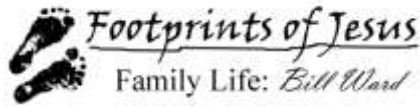

Two are now waiting to be baptized. We hope May 1st will be the day this can happen. Ten Bibles have already been distributed and requests have been made for 22 more. God's Word will help change these men in the jail. Dave Huffman is also going to help in the near future in this ministry. Thanks to these willing workers.
