Will You Make A Visit?

1. **A new couple visits our services.** A few people speak to them. We send a letter expressing our appreciation for their visit, but will they return without a personal visit??
2. **A lonely person is in a nursing home.** Occasionally someone stops to visit. This member enjoys these special times with fellow church members so very much.
3. **An elderly member is home.** Because of health and advanced age, he or she rarely attends worship. In past years they never missed a service, but now rarely does anyone remember to visit them.
4. **A new family places membership.** Perhaps the preacher will visit them, but it would mean a lot if several members of the church would stop by and get acquainted.
5. **A member of the church is beginning to miss services.** A phone call, special note, or visit with encouraging words from concerned Christians may save the day. Are there any that will make the call?
6. **A member of the church loses a loved one.** They are not in our "close circle." Should we not try to comfort them as well?
7. **A new convert is baptized and added to the family.** They need special encouragement and teaching. They need a family who will look out for them at services or help them connect with a family with similar interest.
8. **Is there a visit you need to make? Don't put it off! Do it today and make it a regular habit of your everyday Christianity!**
