## ***Every Member Is Necessary***

In 1st Corinthians 12, the apostle Paul compares the church of Christ (his body) to the human body. He said there are no unnecessary members. All the parts of the body are essential. It is not enough to have eyes to see, we need ears to hear. The hands need the feet. In the same way, different members of the church have differing roles to play. If one member does not do its job, the body is to that extent deficient.

Corporate worship is very important or God would not have decreed it. However, there is much more to church than our assemblies. The 'one another' passages in the scriptures are numerous. They indicate how dependent we are on one another. We will notice some of them and see their importance.

We are told to instruct [admonish] one another, Rom. 15:14. In the same chapter we are told to accept, or receive one another, Rom. 15:7. Evidently some had rejected others on the basis of what they ate or did not eat.

Peter said we are to live in harmony with one another, 1 Pet. 3:8. He also said we must offer hospitality to one another. 1 Pet. 4:9.

Paul wrote that we are to serve one another, Gal. 5:13; and to greet one another, 1 Cor. 16:20.

We are to bear with one another, Eph. 4:2. If wrongs have been committed, we must be compassionate and forgiving, Eph. 4:32.

We are told to edify [encourage] one another. 1 Thess. 5:11. We are also to comfort one another, 1 Thess. 4:18.

We are to exhort one another, Heb. 3:13. This keeps us steady in the boat. It helps us to be active and remain faithful.

All these things take place because we love one another, John 13:34.

How can we do all these things for one another if all we do is come into the house of worship for an hour, leave quickly and have no other contact with our fellow Christians?

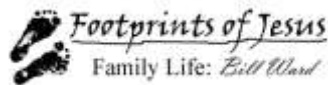

### Tribute to Sister Inez Williams 1916-2010

Sister Inez crossed the great divide early on the Lord's day July 18<sup>th</sup>. She had been desperately ill for several days and surrounded by her family all of that time. Until July 10<sup>th</sup> she was able to live at home.

Her last services at Forrest Park were the worship services on July 4<sup>th</sup> morning and evening. She was unable to come to Bible School that day.

Sister Inez Williams was baptized in 1928 or 1929 at Clear Pool, or Glen Pool, in the Glen Section of east Lowndes County at the Echols County line going toward Statenville. She attended services then at the Black family Schoolhouse in that neighborhood.

She moved to town and later married Bill Williams in 1946. A beautiful girl, Ann, was born into their family.

Her brother, Jimmy, owned the store on River Street where the River St. church first began meeting in 1942. Soon after the Williams moved to their present home on River Street, in 1960, they sold a lot to the River St. church for parking. The dining room of their house was sometimes used as an extra classroom for overflow before the congregation moved to larger facilities at Park and Forrest Streets.

Sister Inez and her husband were ready to every good work. Galatians 6:10. Revelation 14:13 reminds us "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord.. We are so grateful for her faithful devotion to the cause of Christ at River St., Forrest Park, and Latin America.
